This pricing schedule contains details of the VBC Checker pricing structure. The pricing defined below is for illustrative purposes only, NECS will discuss requirements with the customer to ensure the solution offered is fit for purpose and meets the customer's needs.

1. Pricing Structure

The price is unaffected by the number of users registered for the system. Potential purchasers of this system would typically be a CCG, Local Authority or combination of organisations such as an STP, ACS, ICS and therefore the price is based upon the combined population served by the participating organisations.

Cost is based on patient population, per annum and is exclusive of VAT (where applicable).

The costs detailed above are solely for the license (and usage) of the system. Further, wrap-around Programme Management support is available, costs of which are provided on a bespoke basis depending upon customer requirements.

For customers where the local or combined population is over 300,000, NECS will work with the customer to calculate a cost bespoke to the customer's needs, and in relation to the overall population size.

2. Training

Training requirements for VBC Checker are minimal due to the intuitiveness and simplicity of the product and as such, training is invariably conducted through virtual training sessions via WebEx. Full training provision is included within the Programme Management wrap-around service, where requested from the customer, however, for customers who only wish to purchase the license for the system, then on-site and virtual training can be arranged at the Customer's request. Pricing for this service will be discussed with the customer on a bespoke basis, but for illustrative purposes, training sessions are charged at £400 + VAT (where applicable) per day, plus reasonable expenses.

3. Payment Protection

NECS reserves the right to claim interest from the customer under the Late Payment

of Commercial Debts (Interest) Act 1998 at the current rate in force from time to time (before as well as after judgement) in respect of the late payment of any sum properly due. If the Late Payment of Commercial Debts (Interest) Act 1998 does not apply, NECS shall, at its sole option, be entitled to claim interest on any overdue sum at the rate of 4% per annum above the base rate from time to time of Lloyds TSB Bank PLC from the due date of payment until payment in full is made and whether before or after judgement.

Without prejudice to any other remedy available to NECS, in the event of any failure by the customer to pay any sum due to NECS by the due date for payment or if the customer shall be in breach of any of its obligations, NECS shall be entitled to suspend access to the VBC Checker (and therefore suspend the licence granted, as in the Terms and Conditions document), or suspend any services provided by it, until payment in full is made to NECS.

In the event that any suspension of access to the VBC Checker or suspension of services under Clause 2.2 lasts for a period in excess of thirty (30) days, NECS shall be entitled at its sole option to terminate access to the VBC Checker system without any further liability on NECS' part.
