Business trends

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) – Effective May 2018



- ▼ Applies to all entities that hold or process EU data subjects' personal information
- ▼ Direct obligation on data processors globally for EU data subjects
- ▼ Imposes a radical, much tougher data protection regulatory regime
- ▼ Mandates that organizations be compliant and demonstrate their compliance all the time



- ▼ Makes organizations liable for substantial penalties (4% of global turnover or 20 million euros whichever is higher), making it essential for organizations to adhere to GDPR
- ▼ Susceptible to greater risk of liability for class actions (no material damages needed)

Client needs and challenges

Greater responsibility for personal data

- Responsible if data given to another organization to process
- Data processors have direct obligation for EU residents' data wherever they are globally
- Need to ensure data only used for purpose for which consent has been given

Risks involved

- Risk of noncompliance
- Noncompliance makes organizations liable for substantial penalties
- Risk of class action

Demonstrate compliance

- Greater transparency
- Regulation of information
- Access and communication of individual's data

Impact of systems holding personal data

- Need to apply required updates to systems and processes to manage the vast volume of data
- Need to ensure that data subject's consent is recorded
- Need to ensure system can handle potential high volume of requests for personal data
- Knowledge of customizations' impact on personal data may not be available inhouse

GDPR imposes a radical and tougher data protection regime



Anticipated steep rise in requests for personal data



Adherence is mandatory to avoid penalties



Anticipated increase in workforce to support adherence

Non-adherence to GDPR requirements is likely to draw heavy penalties and makes organizations susceptible to class actions.

Most organizations likely to see steep rise in requests for personal data post GDPR

GDPR also stipulates that organizations respond within reasonable timelines for all requests

4% of global turnover or 20 million euros, whichever is higher

Data subjects no longer need to prove material damage, making organizations susceptible to class actions

Anticipated steep rise in volume for personal data requests would force organizations to increase workforce and financial burden to handle those requests

Value proposition

The introduction of GDPR in May 2018, has placed a burden on all organizations holding or processing personal data to demonstrate that these details are accurate and only being held for the purposes to which the individual consented.

Automation and standardization

Automation of reporting process produces consistent results and minimizes the amount of manual intervention required to produce the reports, as well as reducing the need to recruit additional staff to support the new regulations.

GDPR compliance support

A “Personal Details Report” contributes to the demonstration of compliance to the regulations, that a process has been put in place and that a high volume of requests for personal data can be responded to within 30 days.

Rapid and quick reporting

Running large numbers of reports during working hours can impact system performance as it copes with high traffic volumes across the network and then processing power required to generate the reports. Scheduling this activity for off-peak periods minimizes impacts but leaves the option to run on demand if/when required.

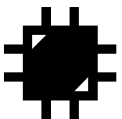

Offering description

Following the implementation of GDPR in May 2018, it is anticipated that there will be a vast growth in demand from EU nationals to know what personal details are held by various organizations.

DXC has developed a “GDPR Personal Details Report” that can be run on demand to extract relevant data from Oracle applications. This can be extended to include data held in user-defined fields, custom tables and industry specific or specialized modules within the wider suite of applications by engaging with DXC’s Oracle Consulting and Advisory services.

Insurance

Trends

- Insurance industry main driver is risk management, which requires large volumes of personal data for actuaries to derive information.
- Large volumes are stored for policy holders with increasing quantities resulting from the growth of online quotes.
- Insurance companies, purely by the type of data they hold and use, are affected by GDPR requirements.



Retail

Trends

- Retail organizations hold a lot of personal details including credit ratings and financial transactions, i.e. where the account holders spend their money.
- This data is of great value to the these and other organizations to know where to target marketing campaigns.
- Retail organizations are working hard to meet their industry compliance requirements and GDPR will add to that burden.



Utilities

Trends

- With the ease of movement customers have between utility providers today the companies need to be mindful of what customer personal data they hold, who they pass it on to.
- If the utility organization does not know what personal data it holding or where it is in their systems then they could be liable under the new regulations when they are audited by external compliance organizations.

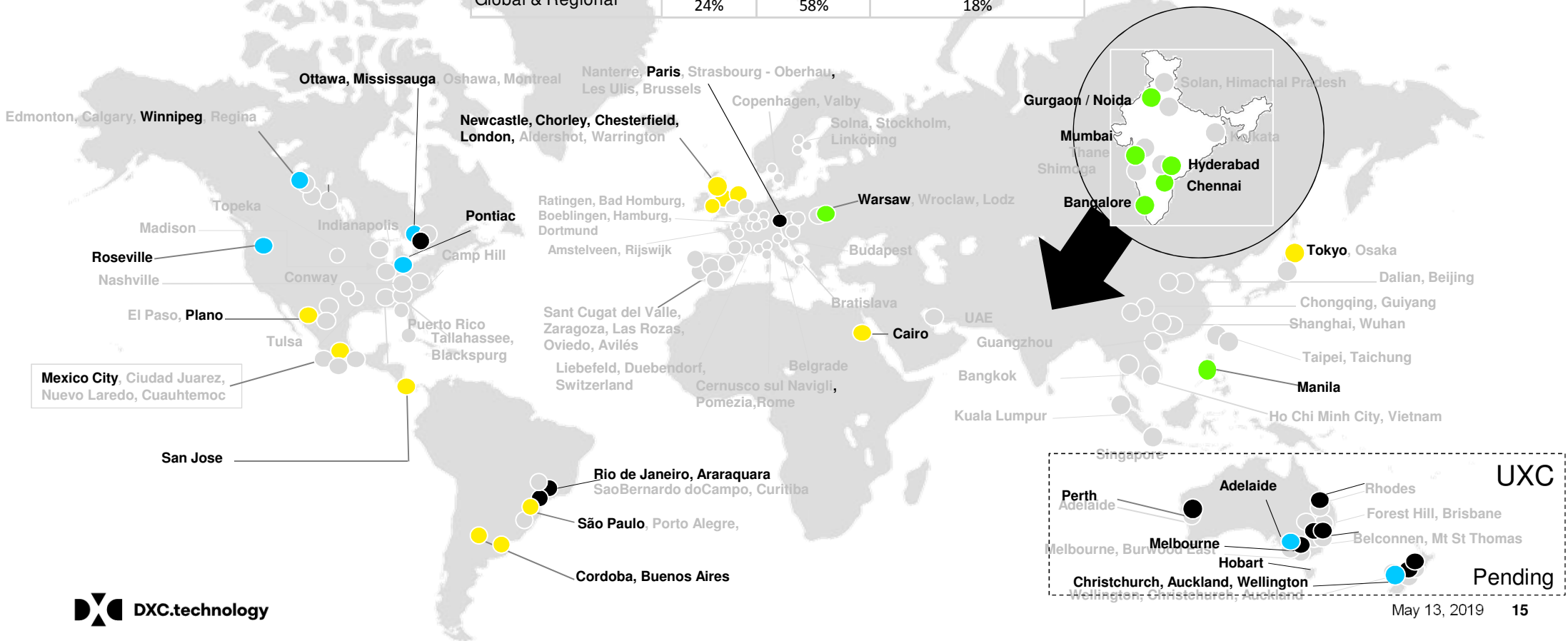

Large

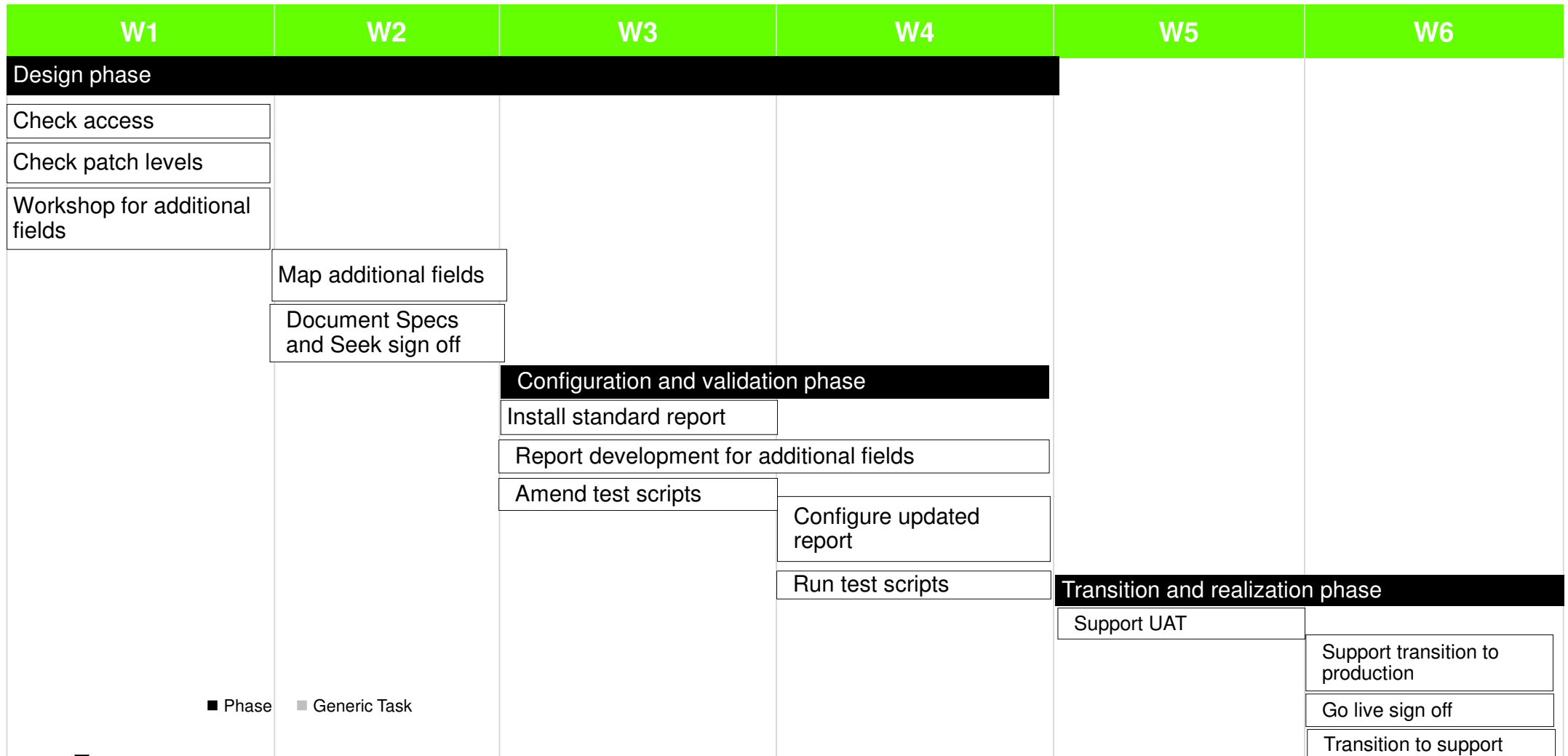
