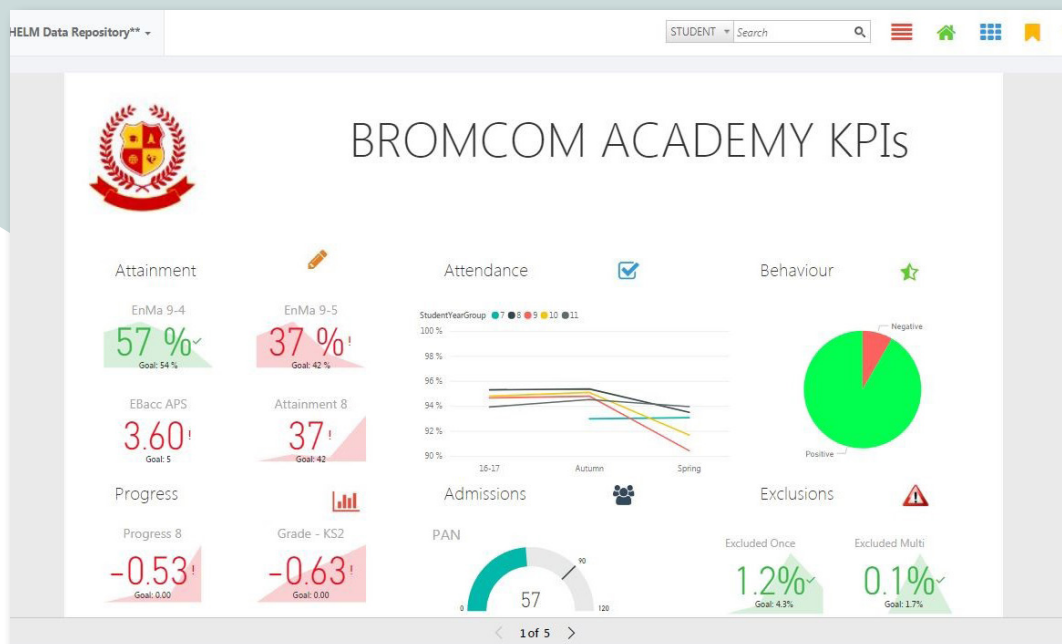
Service Overview

The Bromcom Cloud MIS is a fully managed school management information system (MIS) hosted on Microsoft's Azure platform, guaranteeing 99.95% uptime. Bringing teachers, support staff, parents and students together in a single, online system, Bromcom MIS provides a powerful suite of administration, reporting and communication tools that enable everyone to work together to improve outcomes for young people.

Designed with a consistent user-friendly feel, training requirements are minimal. Teachers can take registers, enter assessment marks and log behaviour incidents after seeing a five minute demonstration of the system.

Helping schools reduce workload is central to our ethos, so the MIS provides facilities to enable schools to automate regular routine activities such as generating reports, escalating behaviour rewards and triggering interventions. From printing class lists to texting parents, your support staff will love the way all the actions they need to take are accessible from a single pupil details page. Your assessment lead will be able to set up our primary tracker in minutes, unlocking a powerful suite of premade reports for identifying gaps and planning for progress.

The MIS has a modular structure with stepped pricing to allow schools to choose a package that matches their needs and available resources. The Standard package contains the minimum requirements for a school to function effectively, the Plus package contains additional modules for pupil and parent engagement and the One-Stop-Shop offer combines the Plus package with our latest developments for pupil safeguarding, parental communication and payments for meals, clubs and trips. Combined with the Finance module all the functionality your school needs to thrive you will find in Bromcom.





Administration

Management of pupil, staff and contact records, with sibling links and intelligent address change features. Pupil and Applicant details can be imported and exported by CTF and ATF and the system is fully GDPR compliant with a 'right to be forgotten' feature. The system maintains a complete record of all mandated employee background checks, with evidence attachments and a variety of reporting options for the Single Central Record.



Assessment

Assessment manages progress tracking and monitors attainment with marksheets adapted for summative and formative assessments. Analyse progress using progress/tracking grids, review Average Points Scores and use trends to predict future attainment. Use of master templates means that a secondary school tracking system can be set up from scratch in under an hour.

As a Bromcom MIS user, you are given free access to our shared online library of assessment resources, which cover statutory needs and provides Assessment without Levels tracking designs that can be used 'out-of-the-box', adapted before use or else used as references whilst devising your own progress tracking solution.

Statutory assessment is just as straightforward, with marksheets adapted to DfE specifications automatically created and assigned to the relevant teachers.



Attendance

Quick and efficient attendance registration via any device including adaptive mobile/tablet sites and teacher app. Statutory (AM/PM), Lesson, Club and Trip Registration are included and you can automate SMS/email/Push notifications to parents alerting them to their child's absence. Plus, create seating plans with pupil indicators of contextual factors and current/target grades by drag and dropping student photos.

Missing Registers routine identifies and prompts teachers to take the register. Daily and Weekly attendance reports can be scheduled and dynamic report groups created to alert relevant staff the moment a student's attendance falls below a set threshold.



Census

Fully integrated DfE census module that makes meeting the DfE statutory returns quick and easy for all three School Census returns and the School Workforce Return. Census provides the DfE summary and validation reports, with links to the appropriate MIS record if issues are highlighted. Also provides the CES Census for Catholic schools.



Cover

User-friendly drag and drop interface to deal with both unforeseen staff absence and planned absence quickly and efficiently, minimising disruption to the school day. Create staff absence records, arrange cover and room changes from the same screen. Covering staff receive dashboard notifications.



Manages the structure of the school day, academic calendar and the timetable, which can be as simple as a morning/afternoon form/tutor group registration to a full subject class-based schedule over a multi week cycle. Maintains classes, forms and groups, including dynamic groups that the system will then automatically maintain according to defined rules such as “all pupil premium boys in KS2 with less than 85% attendance” and “all pupils with an education, health and care plan (EHCP) who received a ‘Good Class work’ commendation this term”. As well as lessons, you can schedule after school clubs and trips and monitor participation in them.



Examination

Streamlines the complete internal and external exams’ administration process from start to finish. Includes the ability to edit basedata, make entries for internal and external candidates, automate the creation of exam seating plans and easily identify and resolve clashes. Exam seating plans can be printed with additional information such as special arrangements for candidates and parents and students can access timetables and exam results via their respective portals.



Reporting

The Reporting module combines a number of built in reports addressing common reporting needs with a powerful ad-hoc report writer to develop custom reports and labels for your specific needs. A report scheduler enables automation of regular reports, which can be sent directly to the appropriate staff member. Letters, certificates and reports can be sent electronically to pupils and parents via their online portals, reducing your school's environmental impact while saving money on printing and postage.



Setup

Easily set up and maintain permissions for the MIS and Finance with field level control of view/add/edit/delete privileges. Active Directory, Google and Microsoft login integration as well as time/location access control, two factor authentication and an Audit Trail of system activity. Secure web service API to facilitate third party integration.

Plus Package



Analysis

A graphical analysis and reporting module, which provides performance monitoring of attainment and progress, in internal and examination results, attendance and behaviour. Includes residuals analysis, grade distribution and summary reporting with huge numbers of filtering options available to help compare various pupil cohorts or vulnerable groups, including Pupil Premium, FSM and EAL.

Key stage performance data analysis provides the school with 'headline' performance indicators at KS4 and KS5 for a quick, high-level review, and includes drill down capabilities.



Behaviour

Collect, monitor and report on positive, challenging and neutral behavioural activities quickly and easily. The Bromcom behaviour module is designed to enable schools to implement their behavioural policies in highly configurable workflows that are then consistently applied to the collection of data to automatically generate certificates/letters of concern. The ability to log incidents with two clicks means staff can record behaviour without interrupting the flow of lessons.

Detentions can be triggered by specific events or accumulated behaviour events. Scheduling can be automated according to pre-defined rules, with email/SMS notification to parents, integrated detention registers and follow up actions for non-attendees.



Communication

A Staff/Parent/Pupil electronic messaging system with automatic and manual messaging functions. Create pupil watch lists for attendance and behaviour that send e-mails, push notifications and/or SMS according to defined rules. SMS messaging incurs carrier charges, which are listed in our pricing document. Communications logs are stored in Student/Contact records.



Diary

An electronic diary to aid in the organisation of school scheduled events, parent's evenings, equipment bookings and room bookings. Sync events to the parent portal which can also be used to book appointments.



Dinner

Assists with the management of school dinners. Maintains pupil and staff balances, meal choices and dietary requirements and produces meal registers, dinner money audits and catering returns.



MyChildAtSchool

The parental portal MyChildAtSchool provides real-time pupil information via a secure and easy to use interface, showing timetables, homework diary, attendance (today and historic), Behaviour, Exams, Assessments, Clubs and Trips. MyChildAtSchool also allows parents to make appointments for parents evenings, give/revoke consent and view announcements, letters and public school diary events.



Student Portal

The online student portal provides pupils with real-time access to their data. Fully configurable by the school, the data shared with the pupils can include their attendance, behaviour, attainment, their lessons timetable, examinations timetable and their results. In addition, the portal can be used to set and mark homework and quizzes and has forums for hosting class discussions.



Support

Advanced Pupil Support provides additional facilities over and above the core facilities that comes as standard to manage SEND, LAC, Health data etc. The Advanced option is specifically designed to meet the needs of staff managing pupil support including SENCOs and G&T Coordinators. It provides functions store/create documents such as Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs), Personal Education Plans (PEPs) etc., scheduling support staff and disseminating information to teachers.

Analysis

Bromcom Analytics: A set of KS4 reports and dashboards that give an unparalleled level of detail into school performance, by individuals, cohorts and key contextual groups. Bromcom Analytics combines forecasts of future performance with trend analyses showing how past predictions translated into exam results.

Advanced Reporting and Analytics: Advanced Report Builder (ARB) is a web-based reporting tool capable of grouping, conditional formatting and rendering charts, tables and graphical indicators. Users can combine data from all areas of the MIS by forming custom joins between tables and perform complex calculations with a wide set of mathematical and logical formulae. Combined with the ability to produce complex reports is the facility to integrate dashboards from commercial business intelligence software such as Microsoft Power BI and Tableau. Live data feeds supply these dashboards with data from across the MIS allowing school, local authority and MAT Leaders to measure the KPIs that matter to them.



MyChildAtSchool

MyChildAtSchool+: This enhancement to the parent portal allows parents to top up their children's dinner money balance, pay for school trips and buy items in an online school shop. The shop is managed via the MIS and includes product photos and stock control.

Enhanced Communications via the MyChildAtSchool App: The parent App is available for Android and IOS smartphones and allows schools to send unlimited push messages with information about students' attendance, behaviour and progress.





Safeguarding

Bromcom have developed a suite of safeguarding functions for recording information and actions for at-risk pupils and keeping key stakeholders informed in a highly secure area of the MIS. An incident log records a description of the incident, its type and any other agencies involved, with a body map and attachment feature for adding evidence to the record. The Safeguarding tab also contains a time chart plotting the occurrence of each type of incident and configurable alerts notify the relevant staff and external stakeholders (if authorised) as soon as a safeguarding incident occurs.

Write Back Licence: This feature allows data collected by third party products to be recorded in the MIS, such as attendance via key card or biometric entry systems.

Parent Pay: This integration allows automatic pupil data and attendance upload from Bromcom to ParentPay.

Extra Storage: The One-Stop-Shop package includes an extra 10GB of document/evidence storage space.

Finance

Finance is a web-based management solution capable of organising all the financial activities of schools and multi academy trusts. Fully integrated with the MIS with single sign on and point of truth, Finance gives control over day to day financial activities including funds, budget control, accounts payable, accounts receivable, and general ledger as well as CFR, Asset Management capabilities and integration with MS Excel and Power BI.

Keith Johnson Options: For customers who require a solution for designing option blocks for KS4 and KS5 we supply 'Options', a robust package from the makers of Timetabler software.

Vivo Interface: A custom interface for recording and managing Vivo points.

London Grid for Learning (Atomwide): A data syncing feature for plugging data from Bromcom MIS seamlessly into Atomwide.

Third Party Applications

We strive to provide all the functionality that our customers want within Bromcom Cloud MIS. However, we also believe the customer has a right to choose from all available providers, so we include in our Standard Package access to a secure API web-service which enables third parties, with a suitable security account, to access a school's Bromcom MIS data. The school is responsible for providing access to their data and defining the permissions for each third party that they allow to access their data using the Bromcom API. Access to the API is free to developers as is a test environment and we have a dedicated Partner Support Team to facilitate the integration of any new service our customers want to use.

Buying Guide

Before comparing prices for a new MIS system, we recommend that you review not only your existing MIS contract but also any third-party products you purchase to cover functionality gaps in your legacy system as it is likely that this functionality is included in Bromcom MIS. Once you have calculated the potential savings by undertaking a total cost of ownership (TCO) analysis, ask for a demonstration to see how those savings can be combined with enhanced processes to improve your school. All our sales representatives are product experts who can explain how the system can be customised to meet the particular demands of your context. Finally, we are happy to provide written answers about current and future developments, so you can be sure Bromcom MIS is the right choice for your school.

Migration to Bromcom

The task of switching from an MIS system that may have been in place for many years can be a daunting one but the skill and professionalism of our Transition Team makes it a smooth process. Once you decide to move to Bromcom you will be contacted by a dedicated Project Manager who will be your single point of contact until your go live date and who will agree a project plan and timeline with you.

Our standard migration from SIMS, CMIS, ISAMS, RM or CTFs is automated with custom software pulling the data directly into Bromcom MIS. Migration from other systems requires the creation of CSV files and may incur additional costs depending on the scope required. Before the live migration a test is carried out that not only allows for extensive testing, it also means training can be carried out on a Bromcom system with your own data. After the live migration the Transition Team make daily calls to key users for two weeks to ensure that they have all the information they need and that the system is living up to our high expectations.

Training

The Bromcom Cloud MIS pricing includes various options for user training, which covers all core functionality. Training is accompanied by supporting documentation written in plain English, training videos and practice logins on a training school Cloud MIS account. The Service provides on-line help, which also links to quick help videos.

Specialist trainers deliver role-based training courses such as 'Office Manager' and 'Assessment Manager'. Each course covers the functionality appropriate to the user and school phase and can be purchased to be delivered on site or via webinar. An extensive library of videos and support materials means that schools have the option of 'self training' which greatly reduces the cost, although we recommend live training of key personnel in the core functionality of the system.

Integrated training videos are embedded in the MIS where they are relevant and increase the ability of users to learn the system as they use it. Bromcom also provides regular targeted refresher training courses via multiple webinars throughout the school year that are free to attend.
