

Sexual Health Tariff Grouper - Basic Provider Service

Background

Sexual Health services are commissioned in England by Local Authority Commissioners. Commissioners are under a statutory obligation to offer open access to suitable Sexual Health services. These services can be commissioned using tariff charging arrangements. Using a tariff based approach provides a greater insight into the care delivered, increases the control commissioners can exercise over their contractual agreements and offers providers more security and control of contractual risk. From the patient point of view, tariffs can promote the delivery of efficient, integrated care.

The Sexual Health Tariff Grouper service offers organisations the ability to easily manage the calculation of Sexual Health tariffs. Tariffs are calculated by analysing the activity data presented by a healthcare provider.

Service Definition

The Basic Provider service enables providers to easily calculate tariff charges agreed with a commissioner. Once a calculation has been completed, the data will be automatically made available to commissioners for review.

The Basic Provider service is designed to offer the minimum viable functionality to calculate Sexual Health Tariffs. The Provider+ service offers enhanced features.
